Prize to be awarded for First in each Class, Prize Cards for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. Prizes to be collected from Pavilion after 2.30pm on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> May. Entries to be collected by Exhibitors after 5.00pm on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> May or Monday 19<sup>th</sup> from 7am to 10am.

All cut flowers and vegetables become the property of the Horticultural Section unless otherwise indicated by the Exhibitor.
