100. Novelty iced cake – judged on decoration only
101. Presentation afternoon tea plate of an assortment of four (4) different pieces to share, eg, small cakes, biscuits, slices etc
102. Chocolate cake
103. Cake, any other variety
104. Muffins, any variety, six (6)
105. Pikelets, six (6)
106. Biscuits or cookies any variety, six (6)
107. Cup cakes – iced, six (6) – judged also on decoration
108. Sweets, any variety, six (6)
109. Slice, any variety, six (6) pieces.
110. Brownies, any variety, six (6) pieces.

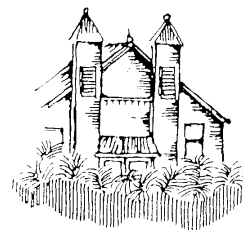
PRIMARY SCHOOL AGE (OR BELOW) ONLY

111. Novelty Iced Cake – judged on appearance only – grade 5 and below only
112. Decorated Eggs, (maximum of 3 eggs) presented in basket or carton (judged on appearance only – bought eggs acceptable)
113. Cake, any variety, (not packet cake) – iced **Year 5, 6 & 7 – Girls**
114. Cake, any variety, (not packet cake) – iced **Year 5, 6 & 7 – Boys**
115. Packet Cake – iced **Year 3 & 4 – Girls**
116. Packet Cake – iced **Year 3 & 4 – Boys**
117. Packet Cake – iced **Year 1 & 2 – Girls**
118. Packet Cake – iced **Year 1 & 2 – Boys**

PREP (OR BELOW):

Open to all children of Prep age (or below), not judged. All entries receive a prize card.
