All entries are to be presented for display at the woodwork shed between 11:00am and 3:00pm on Saturday 1st of May 2010 or Tuesday 4th May between 12:00pm and 3:00pm entries close on the 6th May if you have difficulty in getting your entry to us call Lyn to make some alternate arrangements.

All entries must be accompanied by a correctly filled out entry form. Fees will be per item and are currently \$1.00 for Primary and Secondary Students and \$2.00 for all others. Please indicate your preferences by ticking the appropriate boxes on the entry form each item sold will incur a 20% commission fee which goes towards the running costs of the show. We ask that all entries submitted be no larger than 1 metre square. A time will be set aside for the pickup of all monies and unsold entries which will be on Sunday 16th the last day of the Show between 4:00 and 6:00pm. Should you be unavailable at that time to pickup your items an alternative time and place can be arranged by appointment only by ringing Lyn on 0414 932 022 or 3816 2747.

The Judges decision is final. The Steward reserves the right to alter Prize allocations in all classes if they see fit to do so.

We will take care of the entries to the best of our ability but accept no personal responsibility for any damages while in our care. We have Security personnel on site at the Show and all items will be kept under lock and key at night after the Show closes.
